

Overview of Daily COVID-19 Prevention Measures for Returning to School

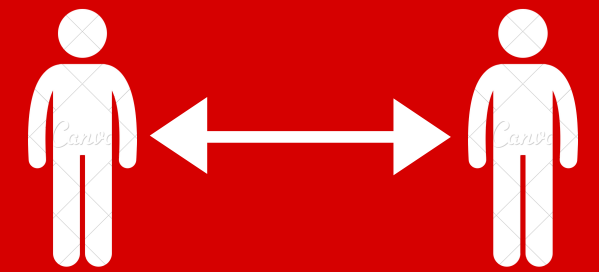
MASKS

- Required for students & staff in buildings when social distancing isn't possible (less than 6-feet)
- During transition times, entering & exiting school, between classes; may be removed during classes and activities when social distancing is possible
- Masks or face coverings must cover the nose, mouth, and chin simultaneously



SOCIAL DISTANCING

- Students should maintain 6-feet of social distance in the hallways during arrival, dismissal, and transition times
- In classrooms, desks will be spaced at the greatest distance the room allows (6 feet, 4 feet, or 3 feet)



LIMIT CONTACTS

- Elementary: Students will be in classroom "families" and will limit interaction with students in other classroom "families"
- Elementary students will eat inside classrooms
- Middle/High: Limit interaction during class changes, eat lunches inside classroom or in cafeteria areas when possible



STAY HOME WHEN SICK

- Students should not come to school when sick
- Students will be sent home when displaying symptoms of COVID-19 including fever, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, loss of taste/smell, new or worsening cough, sore throat, diarrhea, nausea/vomiting
- If a student or employee tests positive for COVID-19, current DHEC guidelines will be followed
- Daily student temperature checks



HYGIENE

- Hand sanitizer stations setup around school
- Breaks to wash hands throughout day
- Drinking fountains turned off but students may use water bottle stations



CLEANING

- Daily school cleaning of hard surfaces and frequently touched areas like doorknobs
- Restrooms cleaned throughout the day
- Regular disinfecting of school and classrooms using an electro-static sprayer
- Additional cleaning each day after students, teachers, and staff are gone.
