

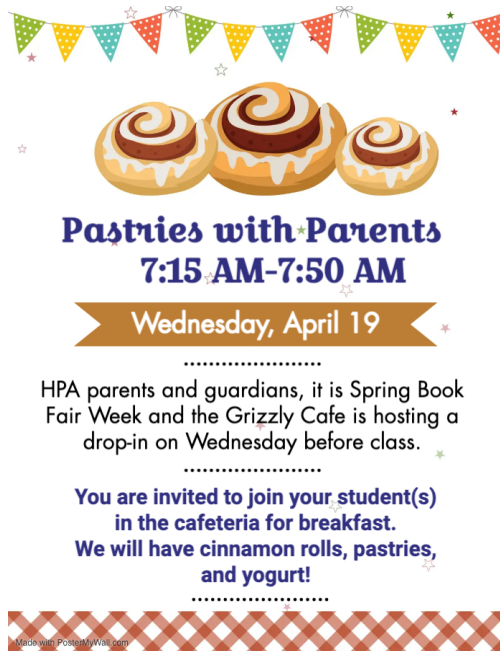

## WHAT SHOULD I BRING?

1. **PICTURE ID:** You will need this to sign in at the front office.
2. **PROOF OF RESIDENCE:** This must show that your residence is in South Carolina. Examples of Proof of Residence include a South Carolina driver's license with your current address, a property tax bill, a water bill, an electric bill, a garbage bill, a gas bill, or a cable bill. (This must be something that is attached to the home.)
3. **REGISTRATION FEE:** The payment to register for Kindergarten is \$50.

**\*\*\*\*This year kindergarten students are the only students who will register in person.\*\*\*** Students in grades 1 - 12, new and returning, will register

online. Families will receive an email in May explaining everything you need to know to register students for the 2023-2024 school year.

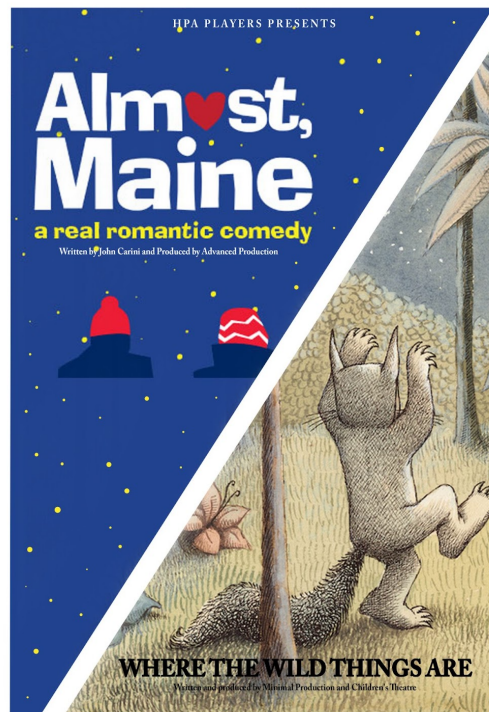
## THEATRE PERFORMANCES

Both shows are FREE and donations are welcome.

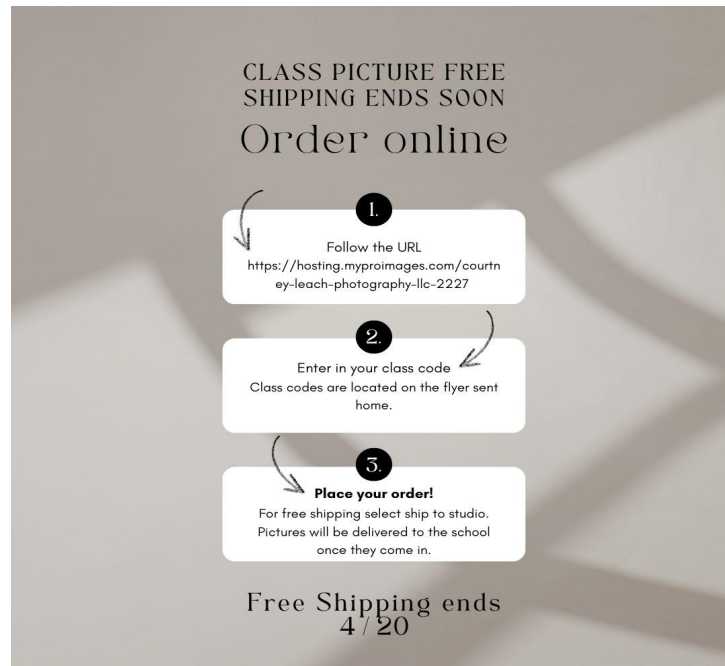
