What should I bring on Saturday?

<u>Proof of Residence</u>: This must show that the residence is in the state of SC. Examples of
acceptable Proof of Residence include an SC driver's license with your current address,
property tax bill, water bill, electric bill, garbage bill, gas bill, or cable bill. (This must be
something that is attached to the home.)

• Payment for the <u>registration fee</u> of \$50 for elementary and \$100 for middle and high school. You will also be asked to settle any outstanding balances.

<u>UNIFORM SWAP</u>: The PTO Uniform Swap is underway. You can send in your student's outgrown uniforms to receive tickets to use in the Uniform Swap during Returning Student Registration on Saturday, May 7.
