

Safety Plan Erin's Law & Gavin's Law

Elementary School

The elementary counselor develops grade level appropriate lesson plans that are presented to students during classroom guidance sessions. The requirements for Erin's Law and Gavin's Law are in the lessons particularly in April during sexual abuse awareness month. Parent communication about this information is related through ParentSquare and parents can choose to opt-out if wanted.

Middle School

This information will be presented to students by the school counselor through character education lessons that will take place in all middle school classrooms during Quarter Three (Jan-March). Parent information and opt-out form will be sent home ahead of time for any parents who do not want their student to receive instruction on these lessons and arrangements will be made for them to participate in an alternate activity. The middle school counselor will work alongside Elementary and High School Counselors to make sure we are providing age appropriate information for our specific grade levels.

High School
