

# Parking information for all High School Students

Every student will display their parking pass on the rearview mirror while parked on campus. The pass must be visible to staff on duty as students enter campus.

The speed limit on the entire campus is 9 mph. The principals, assistant principals, staff members, or school resource officer will have the right to determine who is speeding or operating a vehicle in an unsafe manner by observation. No other proof besides his or her professional judgment is needed. Strict enforcement of the speed limit will be necessary for everyone's protection and safety.

In accordance with state law and good driving practices, seatbelts must be worn at all times by all occupants of vehicles operated on the campus of High Point Academy ("HPA"). Under no circumstances are vehicles to be operated with persons riding on the outside of the vehicle. Students are not permitted to ride in the back of pickup trucks while on campus.

Students will, at all times, operate their vehicles in a safe and courteous manner. Fast or dangerous driving, excessive noise, reckless driving, careening, spinning of tires, or any other hazardous operation of a vehicle will not be tolerated and could result in the loss of driving privileges.

Reckless vehicle operation anywhere on the HPA campus will not be tolerated and is punishable by up to 10 days OSS, possible traffic-related charges by the school resource officer, and loss of driving privileges.

Weapons, illegal substances, and alcoholic beverages are prohibited on campus and are not permitted in vehicles. Smoking, including tobacco products, is prohibited on campus, including in vehicles. The student handbook code of conduct will apply to all infractions.

Riders and passengers of motorcycles operating on campus must wear a helmet.

All parking and driving regulations apply to all students when they are on campus, including extracurricular activities.

No vehicle, including tractors, lawn mowers, ATVs, or any other vehicle which cannot be registered and tagged, may be driven on the High Point Academy campus.

All vehicles must meet the state requirements under South Carolina law for operation on the campus of High Point Academy. This includes up-to-date insurance and a current tag.

All vehicles parked on the property of High Point Academy are under the control of the school administration. All vehicles are subject to search at any time and may be towed upon the authorization of the Superintendent or his or her designee.

All students who park on campus at High Point Academy must purchase a parking permit regardless of the time of year they start to drive on campus. The parking permit must be purchased prior to the first day a student drives on campus.

Parents may not park in the student and staff parking area even when in possession of a student parking pass.

Parking passes are not transferrable between students and cannot be shared.

All parking spaces are on a first-come basis each day.

Students may only park in lined, designated spaces.

Students are not permitted to return to the parking lot or leave campus after arrival on campus.

Sitting in vehicles after arrival is not permitted. Students must exit vehicles immediately upon parking on campus and enter the building.

Students must leave campus immediately following dismissal. Loitering will not be permitted.

# Student Parking Permission Form

Driving to campus and parking on campus is not a right. Parking and driving on campus is a privilege extended to students who agree to follow all campus parking and driving rules and subsequently follow all parking and driving rules while on campus. The parking pass will only be granted following proof of driver's license, proof of insurance, and appropriate signatures on this form. The parking pass can be revoked at any time if the rules are not being followed.
